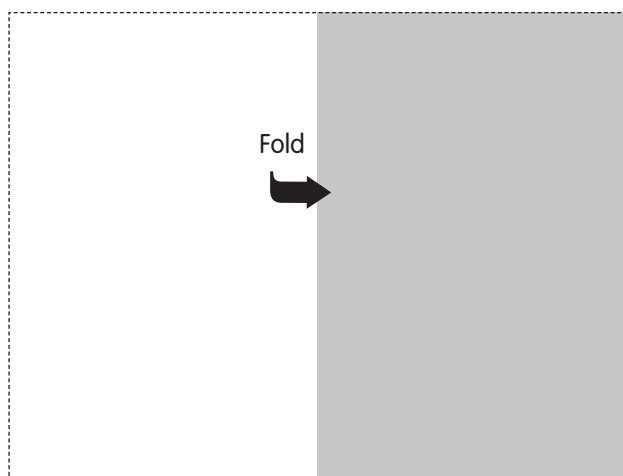
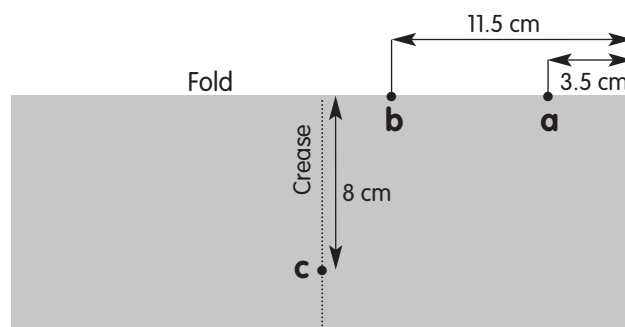


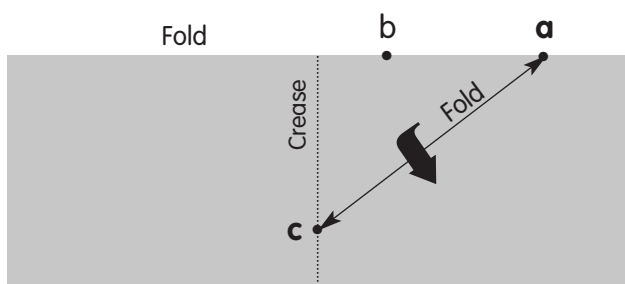
HOW TO MAKE A POP-UP HEART CARD – Paper Engineering



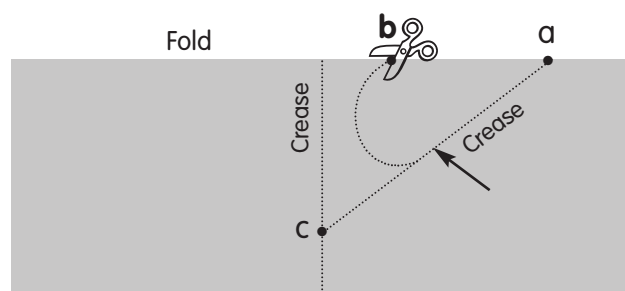
1.
 - Start with a piece of paper 22.9 cm x 30.5 cm.
 - Fold the paper in half, short end to short end.
 - Line up the edges and make a firm crease.



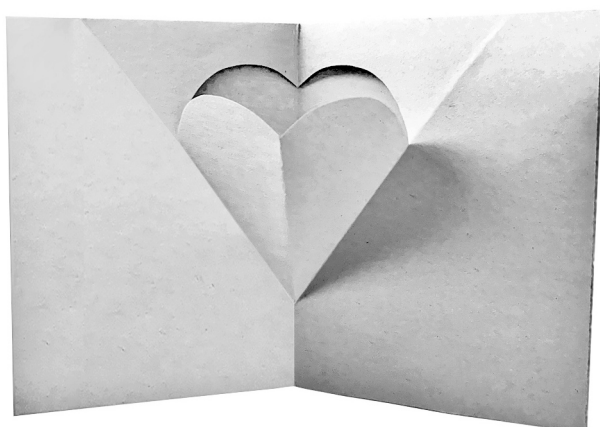
2.
 - Open the paper and fold it in half, long end to long end.
 - Measure and mark **on** the fold:
 - 3.5 cm from the end of the paper - 'a'
 - 11.5 cm from the end of the paper - 'b'
 - Measure and mark **from** the fold:
 - 8 cm along the crease - 'c'



3.
 - Make a diagonal fold from 'a' to 'c' to make a triangle.
 - Stop at the centre crease.



4.
 - Flatten the paper.
 - Start at 'b'.
 - Cut the top part of half a heart.
 - Stop at the diagonal crease.



5.
 - Open the paper.
 - Fold it in half, short end to short end.
 - Start to fold the paper again, short end to short end with the heart on the **inside**.
 - Gently pull the heart forward.
 - Press the fold lines firmly so the heart pops out when the card is open and folds flat when the card is closed.
 - Use crayons, cut paper and/or markers to decorate the front and inside of the card.
